Phileo – affection for friends

Romans 12:10

Be kindly affectionate to one another
with brotherly love, in honor giving
preference to one another

Defining Love



Agape

a choice of individual will to act in the best interests of another, even when another is not fully deserving and even when personal sacrifice is necessary in the action of this affection.

John 3:16

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

AGAPE



Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

AGAPE



1 Peter 1:22

Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart

AGAPE

- Not simply an emotion
- A choice of individual will
- Active even toward those who have not earned it
- Willing to sacrifice for the best interests of its' object
