# Pure Hands

Hebrews 7:26-28

<sup>26</sup>For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens; <sup>27</sup>who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the people's, for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself. <sup>28</sup>For the law appoints as high priests men who have weakness, but the word of the oath, which came after the law, appoints the Son who has been perfected forever.





# Pure Hands

Matthew 27:4, 19, 23-24

<sup>4</sup>“I have sinned by betraying innocent blood” ... <sup>19</sup>his wife sent to him, saying, “Have nothing to do with that just Man” ... <sup>23</sup>Then the governor said, “Why, what evil has He done?” But they cried out all the more, saying, “Let Him be crucified!” <sup>24</sup>When Pilate saw that he could not prevail at all, but rather that a tumult was rising, he took water and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, “I am innocent of the blood of this just Person. You see to it.”





# Pure Hands



Luke 23:41, 47

<sup>41</sup>And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong...<sup>47</sup>So when the centurion saw what had happened, he glorified God, saying, "Certainly this was a righteous Man!"



# Pure Hands

1 Peter 2:21-24

<sup>21</sup>For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps: <sup>22</sup>“Who committed no sin, nor was deceit found in His mouth”; <sup>23</sup>who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously; <sup>24</sup>who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness - by whose stripes you were healed.





# Pure Hands



## 1 Peter 1:13-16

<sup>13</sup>Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; <sup>14</sup>as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance; <sup>15</sup>but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, <sup>16</sup>because it is written, “Be holy, for I am holy.”



# Tender Hands

Mark 10:13-16

<sup>13</sup>Then they brought young children to Him, that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought them. <sup>14</sup>But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. <sup>15</sup>Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it." <sup>16</sup>And He took them up in His arms, put His hands on them, and blessed them.





# Tender Hands

Luke 4:40

When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them.





# Tender Hands

Luke 13:10-13

<sup>10</sup>Now He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath. <sup>11</sup>And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise herself up. <sup>12</sup>But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, "Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity." <sup>13</sup>And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.





# Tender Hands

## Mark 1:40-42

<sup>40</sup>Then a leper came to Him, imploring Him, kneeling down to Him and saying to Him, "If You are willing, You can make me clean." <sup>41</sup>And Jesus, moved with compassion, put out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed." <sup>42</sup>As soon as He had spoken, immediately the leprosy left him, and he was cleansed.





# Tender Hands



## Matthew 11:28-30

<sup>28</sup>Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup>Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup>For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.

## Hebrews 10:26, 29

<sup>26</sup>For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins...<sup>29</sup>Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?
