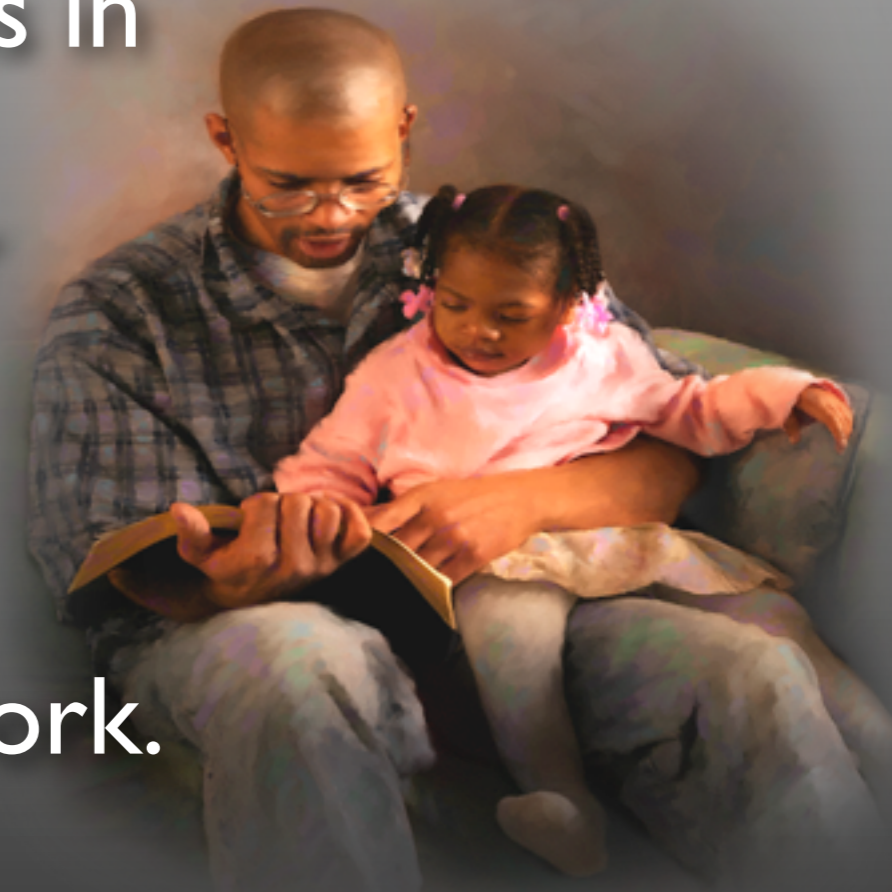

## Hebrews 5:12-14

<sup>12</sup>For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food. <sup>13</sup>For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. <sup>14</sup>But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

# The Infant Stage

- Age: Newborn To Beginning Of Speech
- Begin Reading Bible Stories
- Tell Them That God Loves Them
- Tell Them How Much You Love God
- Sing



# The Parrot Stage

- Age: 1-5
- Memorize Scriptures & Lists
- Read Bible Stories From The Bible
- Train Them To Sit & Listen
- Ask Simple Fact Questions



# The Grammar Stage

- Age: 6 - 9
- Have Them Begin Using Their Own Bible
- Have Them Relate The Stories To You
- Start Working On Timelines & Maps



# The Logic Stage

- Age: 10 - 13
- Begin Asking “Why” Questions
- Teach Them To Use Reference Material
- Teach Them To Judge Everything They Read By The Bible
- Have Them Answer Their Own Questions From The Bible
- Challenge & Include





# The Rhetoric Stage

- Age: 14 - Adult
- Have Them Express What They've Learned
- Give Assignments
- Have Them Make Presentations
- Introduce Them To Teaching
