

# Expunging the Theology of Islam



1. Contrast Muhammad the prophet with Jesus Christ our Savior.

**Muhammad had no prophecies of his coming, performed no miracles, kingdom is warlike, sinned, accepted no worship, claimed to be only a man, never resurrected. Jesus coming prophesied, performed miracles, kingdom not of this world, never sinned, accepted worship, claimed to be God, was resurrected.**

3. How are the *surahs* of the Qur'an arranged?

**From the longest (surah 2) to the shortest (surah 114).**

4. What proofs are given for the inspiration of the Qur'an?

**It beauty, perfect Arabic, errorless, etc.**

5. What are some of the known sources of the Qur'an?

**Pagan poetry and cults, Arabian fables, eastern religions, Judaism, heretical Christianity, Bible, etc.**

6. What is an abrogation? What New Testament passage shows that Jesus did not abrogate the Old Testament?

**Allah abrogates or abolishes a verse in the Qur'an superceded by another.**

**See Matthew 5:17-19; 24:35**

7. Give an example of a self-contradiction in the Qur'an.

**Was the world created in six days or in eight days (surahs 7:54; 41:9-12)? Is man free to make his own moral choices (surah 18:29) or is his actions and fate determined by Allah (surahs 17:13; 10;99,100)?**

8. Give an example where the Qur'an contradicts the Bible.

**Ark rested on Mt. Judi or Mt. Ararat. Isaac not Ishmael (surah 37:100-112) was to be sacrificed. Golden calf was not constructed by Samaritans (surah 20:87,95). Jonah and Samson are said to have lived after Christ.**

9. Originally, who was Allah?

**The moon god, supreme god of the Arabian pantheon of 360 gods.**

10. How do Muslims use the symbol of the crescent moon?

**To adorn their mosques, minarets, and flags.**

11. What is the sin of *shirk*?

**Idolatry or blasphemy against Allah by calling anyone deity but Allah.**

12. What is the purpose of the beads used by Muslims?

**99 beads to count the 99 names of Allah. Only the camel knows the 100<sup>th</sup> name of Allah.**

13. Contrast the God of the Bible with Allah?  
**Allah does not love sinners, God does. Allah can do evil, God cannot. God is Father, Allah never called father. God is knowable, Allah is not.**
