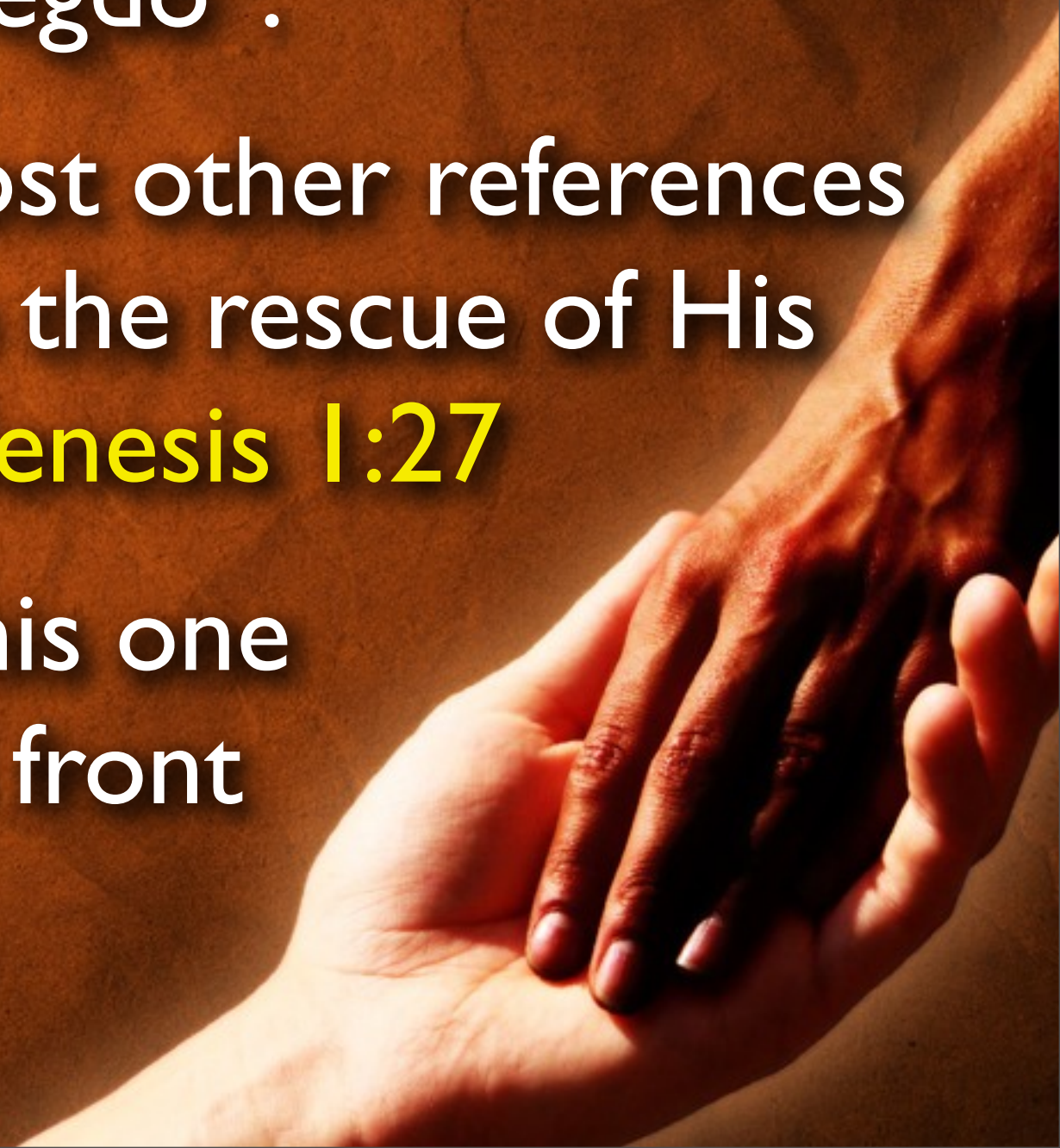

# Genesis 2:18

- “Kenegdo” is only used this one time. It means, “what is in front of, corresponding to” or “facing opposites”.



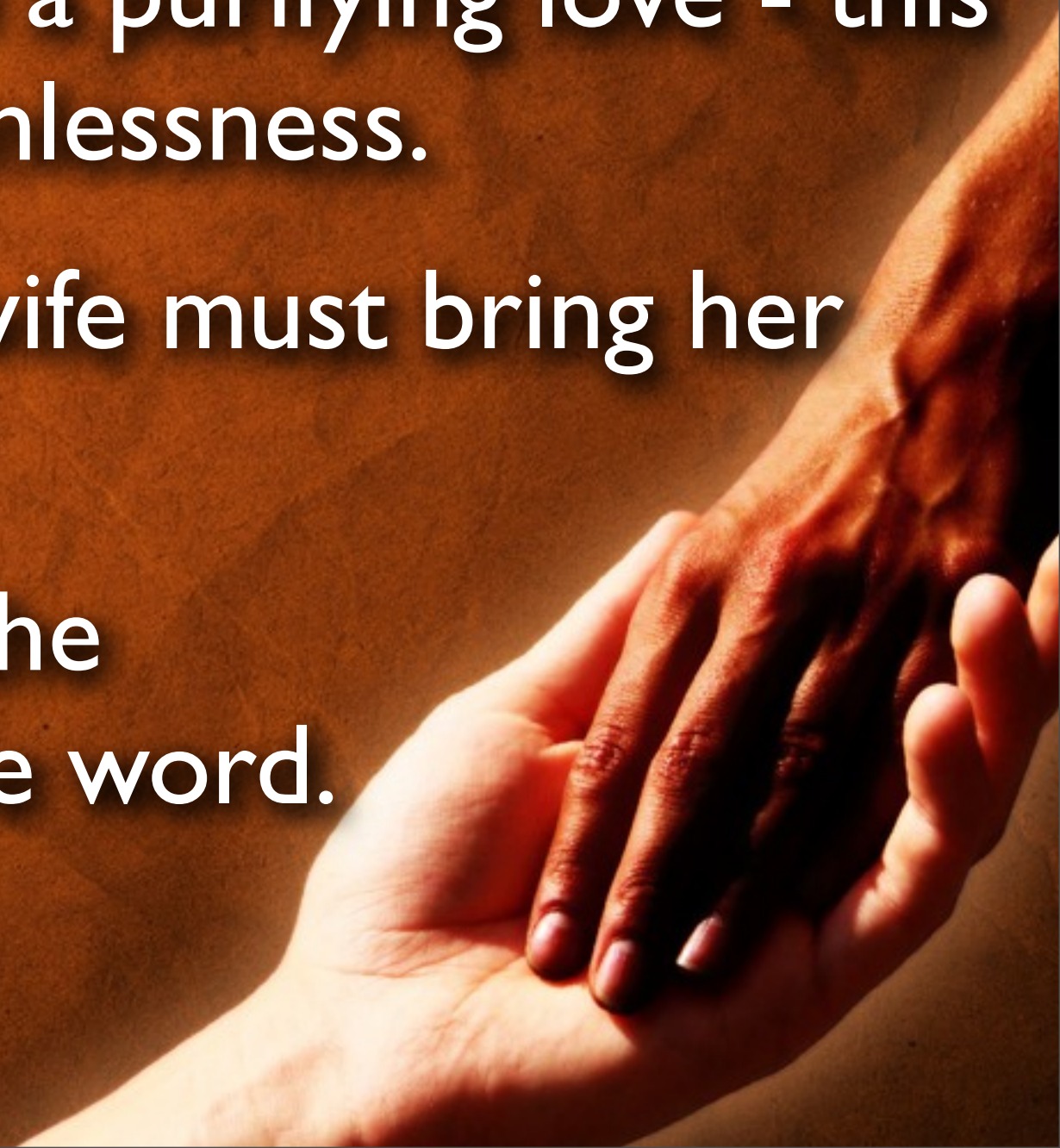
