A Powerful Instrument

- Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.
- Proverbs 18:6-7 ⁶A fool's lips walk into a fight, and his mouth invites a beating. ⁷A fool's mouth is his ruin, and his lips are a snare to his soul. (ESV).

A Powerful Instrument

 Proverbs 15:1-3, 4 - ¹A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. ²The tongue of the wise uses knowledge rightly, but the mouth of fools pours forth foolishness...⁴A wholesome tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit.

A Powerful Instrument

 Proverbs 6:16-19 - ¹⁶These six things the Lord hates, yes, seven are an abomination to Him: ¹⁷A proud look, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, ¹⁸A heart that devises wicked plans, feet that are swift in running to evil, ¹⁹A false witness who speaks lies, and one who sows discord among brethren.

Taming The Untamable

- Proverbs 21:23 Whoever guards his mouth and tongue keeps his soul from troubles.
- James 1:26 If anyone among you thinks he is religious, and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this one's religion is useless.
- Ephesians 4:29 Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear. (NASB)
