### JOSEPH FLEES

**GENESIS 39** 

- Why did Joseph run from Potiphar's very likely super attractive wife?
- How could he resist her persistent advances?
- Why did Joseph consider it a great wickedness and sin against God, but said nothing of Potiphar?
- Why does God ask this of him and us?

6... Now Joseph was handsome in form and appearance. 7 And after a time his master's wife cast her eyes on Joseph and said, "Lie with me." 8 But he refused and said to his master's wife, "Behold, because of me my master has no concern about anything in the house, and he has put everything that he has in my charge. 9 He is not greater in this house than I am, nor has he kept back anything from me except you, because you are his wife. How then can I do this great wickedness and sin against God?" 10 And as she spoke to Joseph day after day, he would not listen to her, to lie beside her or to be with her.

### **OUR RELATIONSHIP TO GOD**

- How do you view your relationship with the Creator of all things?
  - Romans 6:18-20 Are we only servants or slaves?
  - Romans 8:17 Adopted children, co-heirs with Christ?
  - 1 Peter 2:9 Chosen race, royal priesthood, people for His own possession?
- How else does God see it?
  - 2 Corinthians 11:2 we are betrothed to one husband, to present us as a pure virgin to Christ
  - Ezekiel 16

#### **BACK TO JOSEPH**

- Understanding his relationship to God he showed us how to handle temptation (sexual, yes, but ALL), but ultimately how to value our relationship to God
  - Of course God would have forgiven a repentant Joseph, I mean c'mon right?
- What was Joseph thinking?
  - Proverbs 1:10-16

#### Proverbs 1:10-16

10 My son, if sinners entice you, do not consent.

11 If they say, "Come with us, let us lie in wait for blood; let us ambush the innocent without reason;

12 like Sheol let us swallow them alive, and whole, like those who go down to the pit;

13 we shall find all precious goods, we shall fill our houses with plunder;

14 throw in your lot among us; we will all have one purse"—

15 my son, do not walk in the way with them; hold back your foot from their paths, 16 for their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed blood.

#### SIN IS CHEATING
