What we say . . . says something

"A collective noun is the name of a group or class considered as a unit; e.g., flock, class, group, crowd, gang."

Examples:
One link is not a chain
One cow is not a herd
One Christian is not a church!
1 Corinthians 12:12,14; Matthew 18:15-20

A Collective Noun

"n. Grammar. A noun that denotes a collection of persons or things regarded as a unit."

Units:

- Israelites Acts 7:38 (KJV, "church"; NASB, "congregation"-see footnote) Moses wasn't a part of the Lord's body. It's how the term was used.
- Rioters Acts 19:32 ("assembly"-see NASB footnote) Didn't know why they were called out - just assembled
- Greek citizens Acts 19:39 ("assembly"-see NASB footnote) Purposely assembled.

• Christians - Acts 2:47 (what we're considering this morning)

- **1. UNITS Christians**
- **2. COMMON CHARACTERISTIC being in Christ**
- 3. The whole body of Christians, or, the collectivity comprising all those called out of the world by the gospel into the fellowship of Christ Matthew 16:18; Hebrews 12:23
- 4. By Various Figures Likened Unto:
 - **Body** 1Corinthians 12:12-14
 - Temple Ephesians 2:20-22
 - Priesthood 1 Peter 2:5
- To be a member of this "church" is to sustain a relationship to the Godhead wherein all spiritual blessings are found! Ephesians 1-3.

The Church - District Sense

- **1. UNITS Christians**
- 2. **COMMON CHARACTERISTIC** living in the same area or district
- **3.** The body of Christians living in a defined area or district Acts 9:31
- The Church Assembled Sense
- **1. UNITS Christians**
- 2. COMMON CHARACTERISTIC physical assembly of the local church
- 3. A physical assembly of the local church 1 Corinthians 11:18,20; 14:19, 23-25

The Church - Local Sense

- 1. UNITS Christians
- 2. COMMON CHARACTERISTIC a specific fellowship, i.e. worshiping and working together in a given locality
- 3. A body or group of Christians worshiping and working together in a given locality 1 Corinthians 1:2,10; 11:20; 14:26; 16:1-2; Philippians 1:1; 4:15; 1:27
 - Not simply assembly (children, unbelievers, meetings, special classes)
 - Not simply geography (not all members live in the locality of the designated church)
- 4. Characteristics of this fellowship
 - Regular assembly for worship and edification (though not by itself sufficient to identify the fellowship)
 - Common oversight under which they operate
 - Common fund through which they work
