<u>2 Corinthians 12:7-9a</u>

"So to keep me from becoming conceited because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to harass me, to keep me from becoming conceited. Three times I pleaded with the Lord about this, that it should leave me. But He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is made perfect in weakness."

<u>2 Corinthians 11:1-3</u>

"I wish you would bear with me in a little foolishness. Do bear with me! For I feel a divine jealousy for you, since I betrothed you to one husband, to present you as a pure virgin to Christ. But I am afraid that as the serpent deceived Eve by his cunning, your thoughts will be led astray from a sincere and pure devotion to Christ."

<u>Genesis 3:1-7</u>

Let's consider the character of Satan with this passage: \bullet He's been sinning from the beginning (1 John 3:8). He's the father of lies (John 8:44). • He's puffed up (1 Timothy 3:6). • He'll disguise himself as an angel of light (2 Corinthians 11:14).

<u>Genesis 3:1-7</u>

<u>2 Peter 2:17-19</u>

"These are waterless springs and mists driven by a storm. For them the gloom of utter darkness has been reserved. For, speaking loud boasts of folly, they entice by sensual passions of the flesh those who are barely escaping from those who live in error. They promise them freedom, but they themselves are slaves of corruption. For whatever overcomes a person, to that he is enslaved."

"Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time He may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on Him, because He cares for you. Be sober-minded; be watchful.
