Ephesians 5:11

What Is Fellowship?

- "Having something in common or a partnership".
 Our English word is derived from words that literally mean "one who lays down money in a joint enterprise" (Luke 5:10)
- It is translated as fellowship, communion, partners, partaker, companion, communicate, distribution and sharing
- Fellowship Is A State Of Being

1 John 1:3-7 - that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ. And these things we write to you that your joy may be full. This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

- 1 John 2:3-6 Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments. He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him. He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.
- God's truth can be understood & practiced by every Christian
- God's message is so clear that we can see His expectations of us and others

- Fellowship with one another is inseparably linked to our fellowship with God
- Fellowship begins and ends on a personal level
- 1 John 1:6-10 If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.

The Limits Of Fellowship

We Are To Treat Those Who Refuse To Repent As Accursed: Galatians 1:6-9; Psalm 5:4-6

We Cannot Encourage, Shield, Or Comfort Them 2 John 9-11; 1 Corinthians 5:11
