Definitions

- **Impute** (Gr. logizomai) : “to reckon; to put down to one’s account”
- Translated “number”, “account”, “count”, “reckon”, “credit”
- It does not mean “transfer” or “attribute what belongs to another”
- **Righteousness & Justification**
 - The behavior expected by God (righteousness)
 - One’s legal status before God (justification)
