BLESSED is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.
2 But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and he will meditate on his law day and night.
3 He shall be like a tree, planted by the water, which bringeth forth his fruit in his season; and his leaf shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

† A Psalm of David. When he fled from Absalom his son.
LORD, how are they increased that trouble me! many are they that rise up against me.
2 Many there be which say of my soul, There is no help for him in God. Selah.
3 But thou, O Lord, art a shield for me; my glory, and the horn of mine horn.
4 I cried unto the Lord with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill. Selah.
5 I laid me down and slept, I awaked; for the Lord sustained me.
6 I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people, that have set themselves against me round about.
7 Arise, O Lord; save me, O my God: for thou hast smitten all mine enemies upon the cheek-bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.
8 Salvation belongeth unto the Lord: thy blessing is upon thy people. Selah.

A David psalm for audience. 2. He reproach and rebuked to enemies. 3. How's happiness is in God's favour.
† To the Chief Musician on Negleoth, A Psalm of David.

HEAR me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged my when I was in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer.
2 O ye sons of men, how long will ye turn my glory into shame? how long will ye love vanity, and speak after leasing? Selah.
3 But know that the Lord hath set apart him that is godly for himself: the Lord will hear when he calleth unto him.
4 Stand in awe, and sin not: commune with your heart upon your bed, and be still. Selah.
5 Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put confidence in the Lord.
6 How many that say, Who will shew us any sign, lift thou up the light of thy countenance upon us.
7 Thou hast put gladness in my heart, more than when their corn and their wine increased.
8 Both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for the Lord only maketh me dwell in safety.

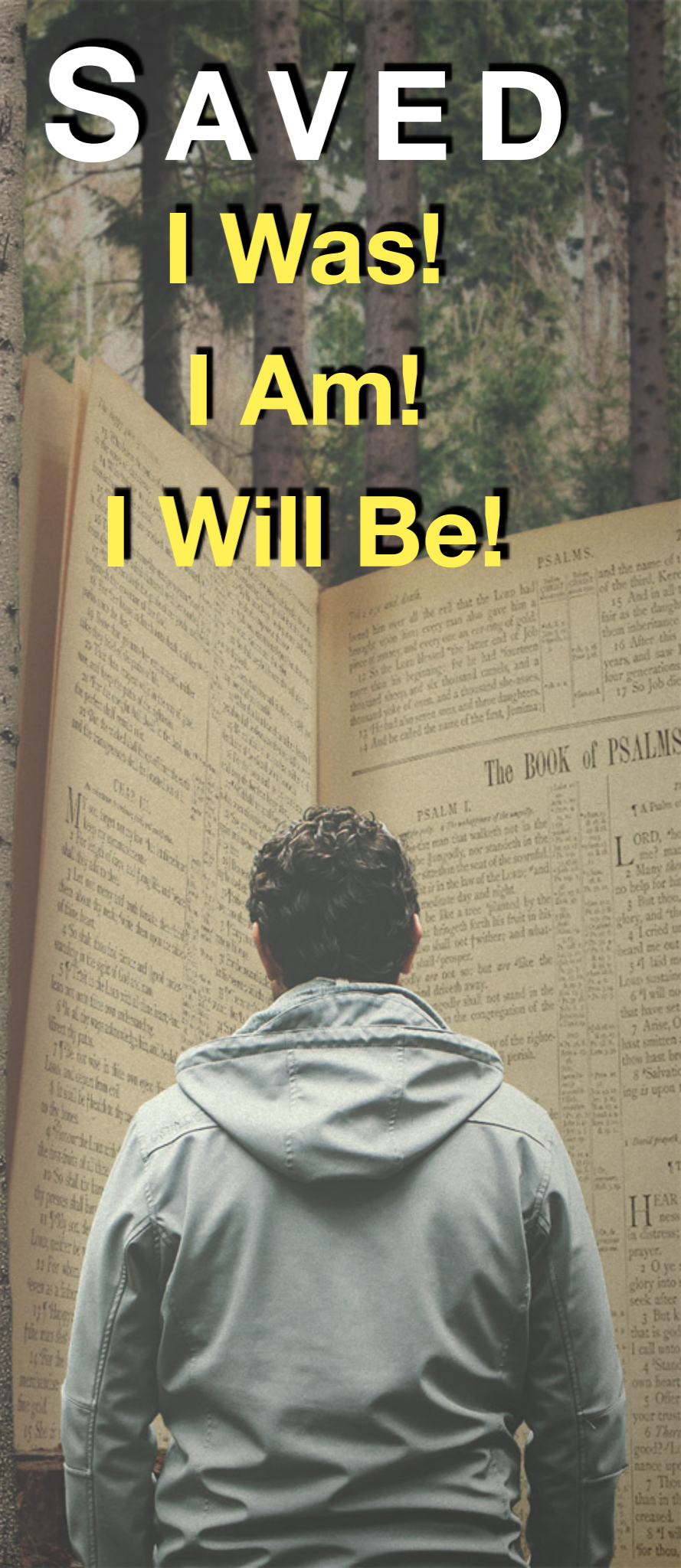

Much more than, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

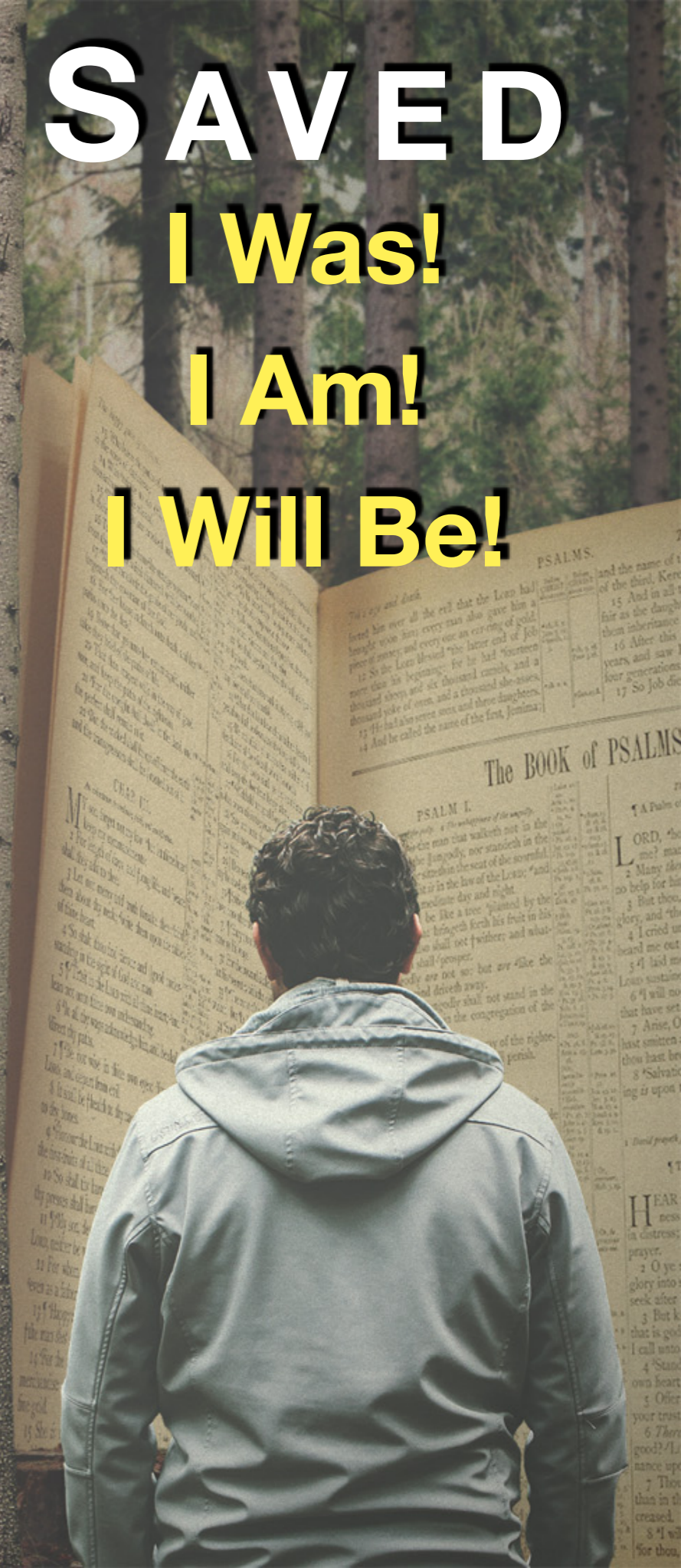
For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.
