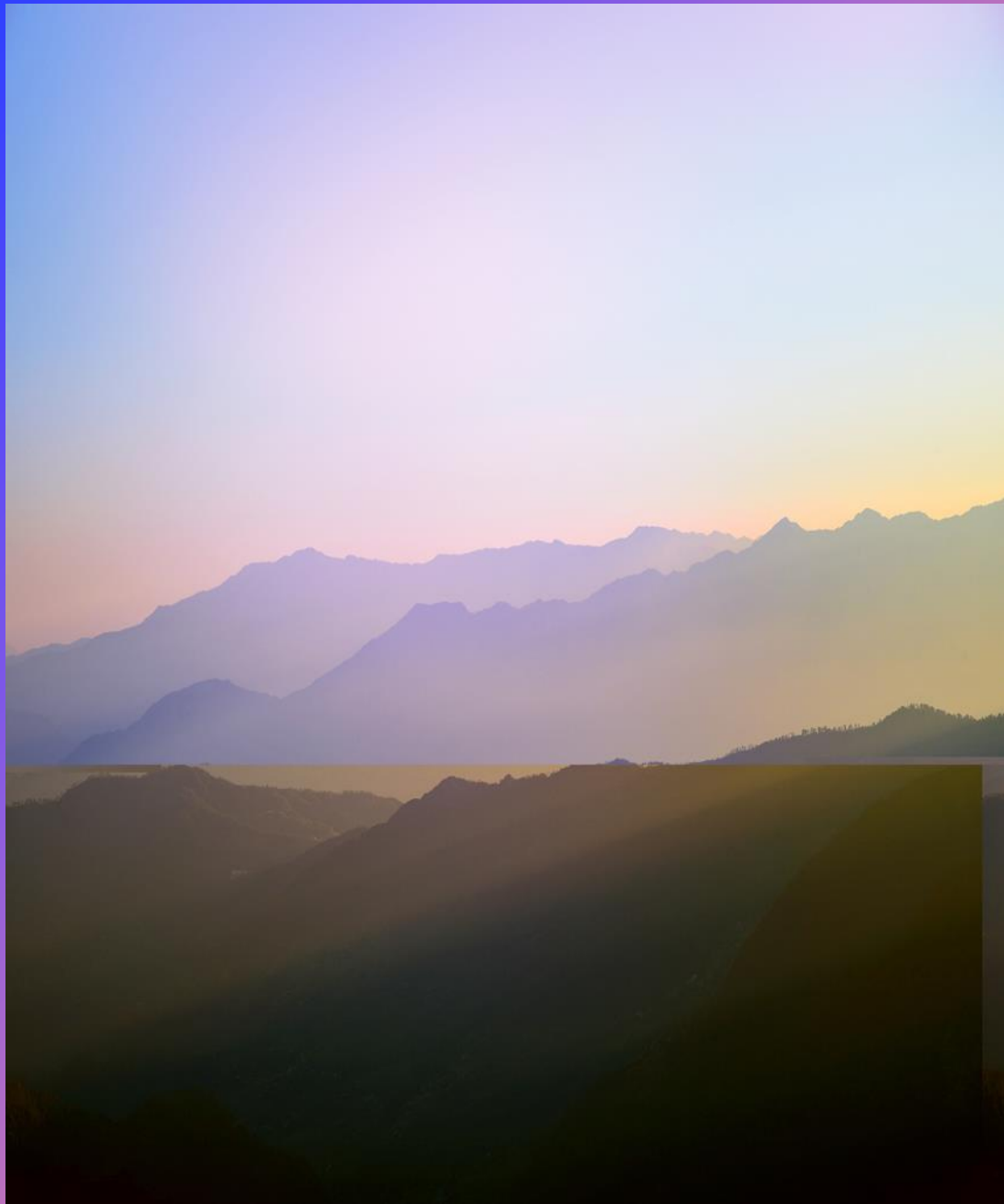

God's word shares with us change that occurred. Will we learn from that change or will we allow history to repeat.

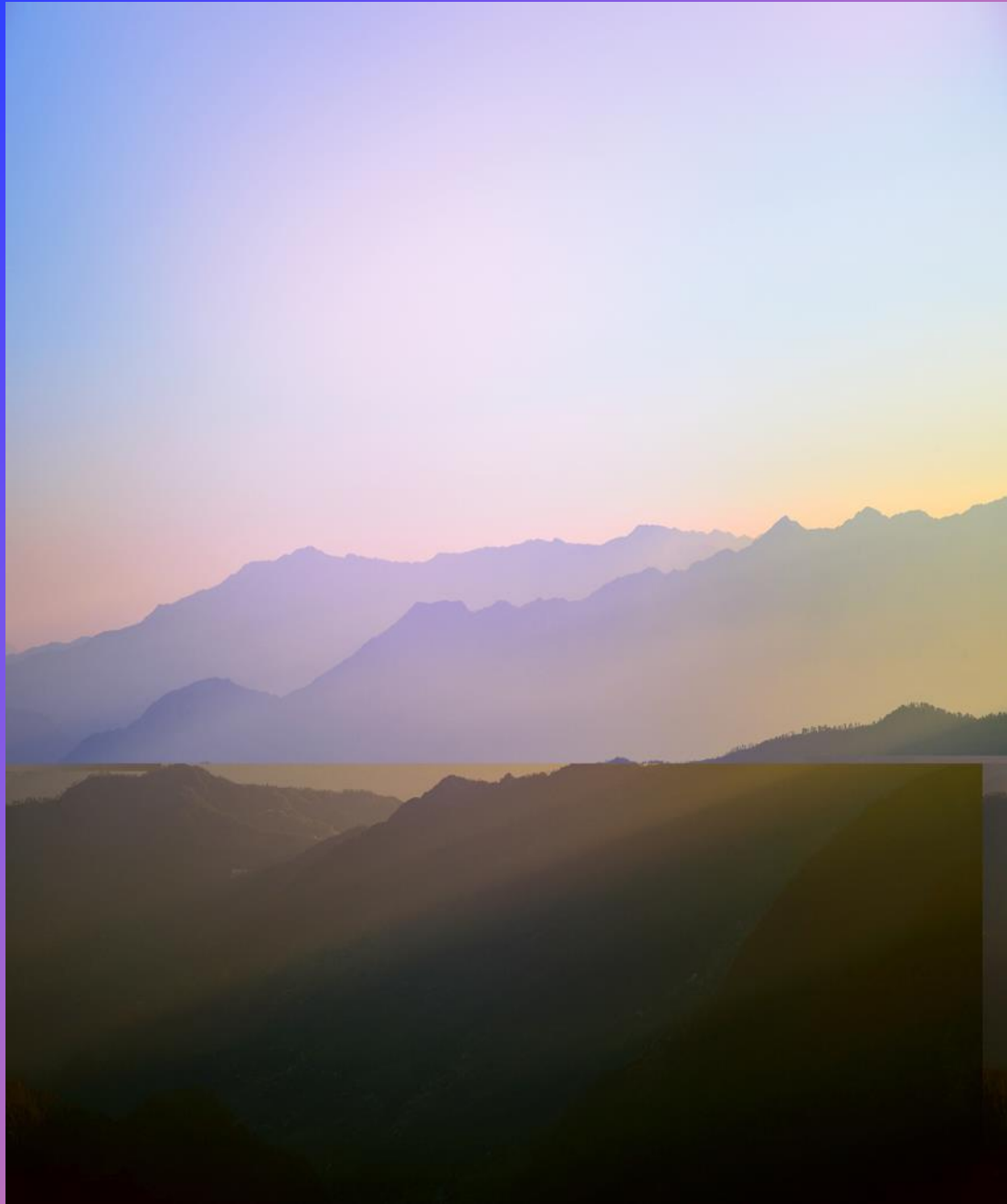
PRESENT

- Repeat!!!!!!



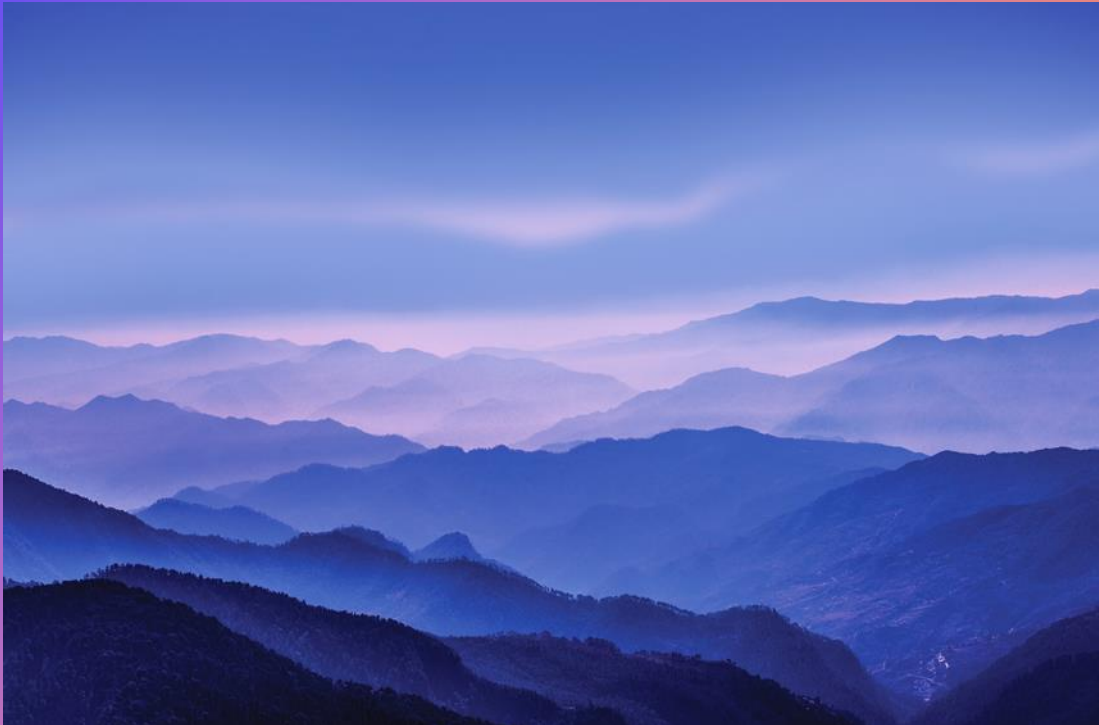
