- “An excessive view of oneself; a high or inordinate opinion of one’s own dignity, importance, merit, or superiority, whether cherished in the mind or displayed in bearing, conduct, etc. Arrogance or majesty; haughtiness.”

Pride (Arrogance)

- **Proverbs 6:16-19** – “...the Lord hates...a proud look...”
- **Proverbs 16:5** - Everyone proud in heart is an abomination to the Lord; though they join forces, none will go unpunished
- **Proverbs 21:24** - A proud and haughty man – “Scoffer” is his name; he acts with arrogant pride
- **Proverbs 3:34** - Surely He scorns the scornful, but gives grace to the humble
- **Proverbs 26:12** - Do you see a man wise in his own eyes? There is more hope for a fool than for him.
