# Selection Process

- Over The Next Two Weeks Please Submit Names To The Elders For Any You Would Like Considered To Be A Deacon
- The Elders Will Review The Names And Talk With The Men Who Were Put Forward
- The Elders Will Then Announce The Names Of The Men To Be Considered
- @30 Day Additional Time To Consider All Names Relative To Qualifications And/Or Address Any Concerns
- End Of 30 (Ish) Day Period - Appoint Selected Men As Deacons
