Historical Background

- Ezra & Nehemiah tell of Judah's return from exile
- Israel went into Assyrian captivity (722 BC)
- Judah goes into Babylonian captivity (606 BC)
- Babylon is conquered by the Persians
- The Persians allow the exiles to return home in 3 waves:
 - Zerubbabel (536 BC)
 - Ezra (458 BC)
 - Nehemiah (445 BC)
