

### Context

the circumstances that form the setting for an event, statement, or idea, and in terms of which it can be fully understood and assessed.

Example: "I'm leaving"

A friend at a party?

A co-worker on the job?

By your spouse during an argument?

### Interpretation

"the action of explaining the meaning of something" – "understanding"

### Exegesis

critical explanation or interpretation of a text

### Eisegesis

process of interpreting text in such a way as to introduce one's own presuppositions, agendas or biases. It is commonly referred to as reading into the text

But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed.


