"Melatao" - to resolve a matter in your mind

"Logizomai" - to take inventory. To reason a matter to conclusion

Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.



"Hagah" - to murmur as you ponder. Talking under your breath.

Joshua 1:8

This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall *meditate* in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.
