- Denotes paying homage, respect by demonstrating love, esteem, and reverence
- Every act has been designed by God for His people to admire and adore Him
- Involves giving up something that you value (Genesis 22; Romans 12:1-2)
- Can be done at a specific time and place:
 - Abraham (Genesis 22:1-5)
 - David (2 Samuel 12:20)
 - The Ethiopian eunuch (Acts 8:27-28)
